

Dear TMS Community,

TMS has received information that a student at our Lower School has tested positive for COVID-19 and is currently receiving direction from Public Health.

Directed by York Region Public Health's Contact Tracing Team, we have instructed the affected student cohort and any household members who are not fully vaccinated to self-isolate until and including Sunday October 17th. **Families in the affected cohort have been notified directly. If you were not contacted, your child's cohort is not affected.**

To protect the privacy and confidentiality of the student, we are not permitted to disclose any further information of a personal nature.

We have worked with and have been directed by York Region Public Health throughout and will continue to do so over the coming weeks. We are required to share a letter from YRPH about this case. Please find it [HERE](#). We encourage you as a routine measure to be watchful of any symptoms and seek testing if your child presents with any symptoms.
